- Consortium partners with a short description of their institutions.

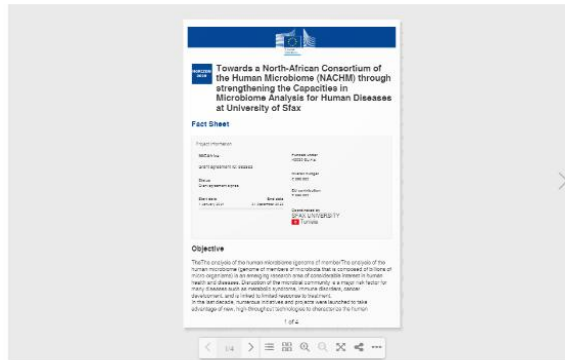


Figure 2: Screenshot of the “About US” section and project fact sheet sub-section.

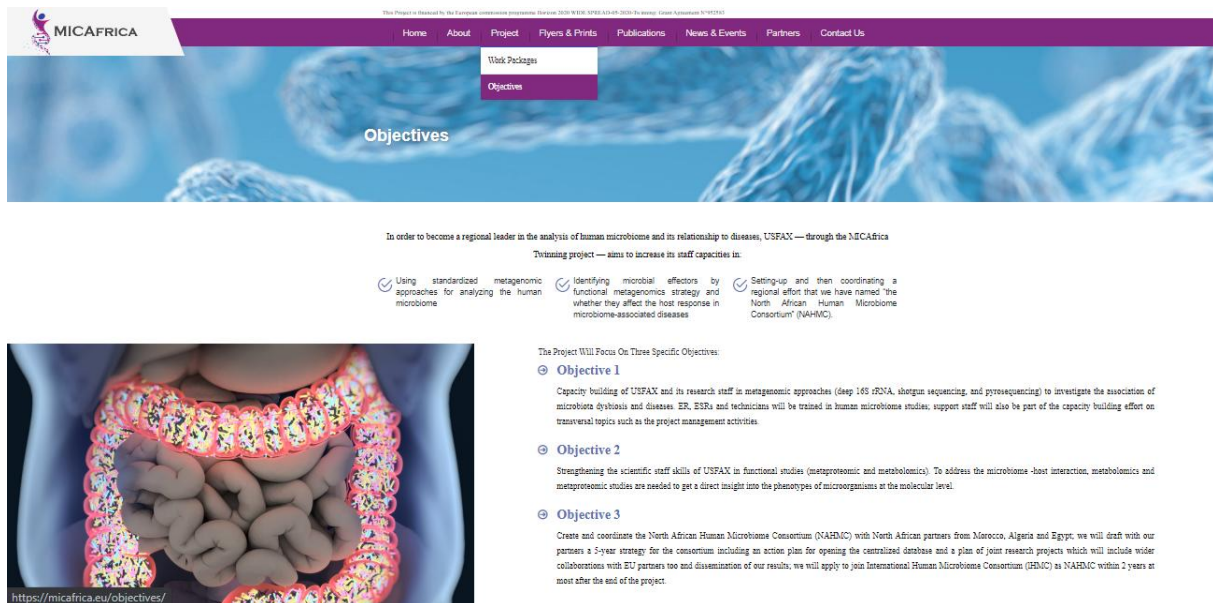
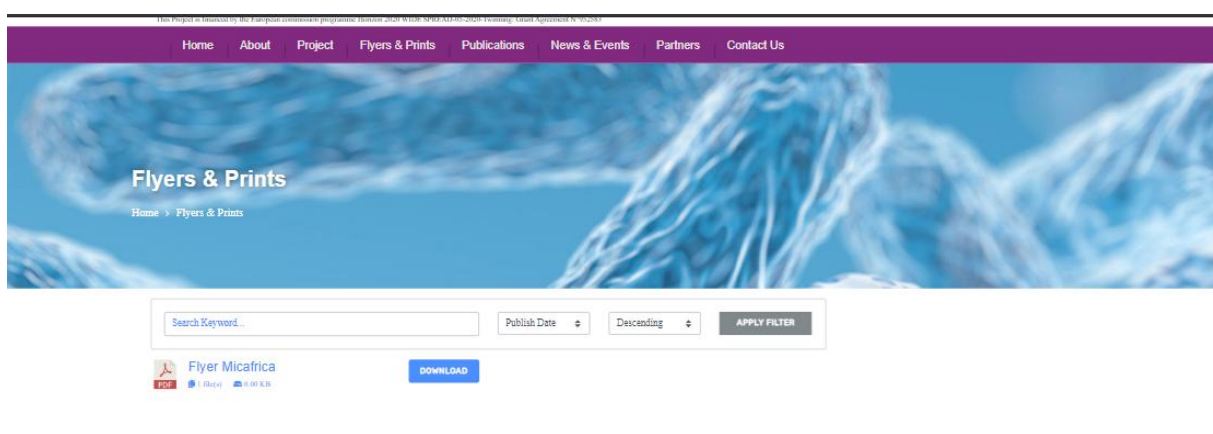


Figure 4: Screenshot of the Subsection Objectives

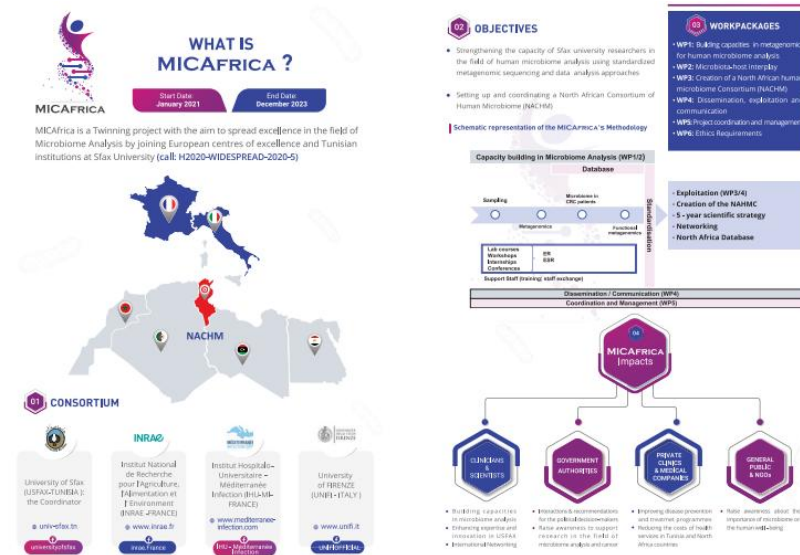


Figure 5: Screenshot of flyers and prints section

- **Research papers:** All the scientific articles that will be published in high impact-factor journals will be available in this section

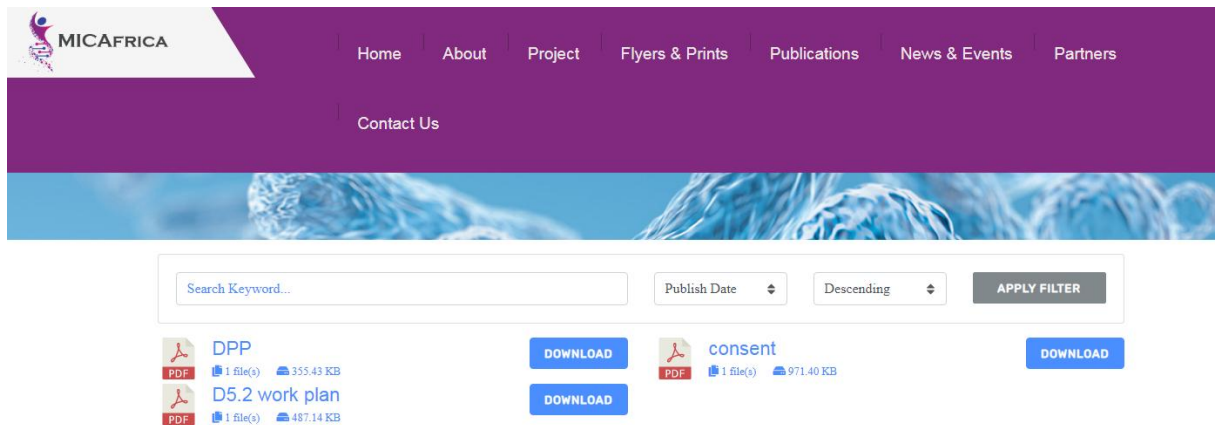


Figure 6: screenshot of publications section

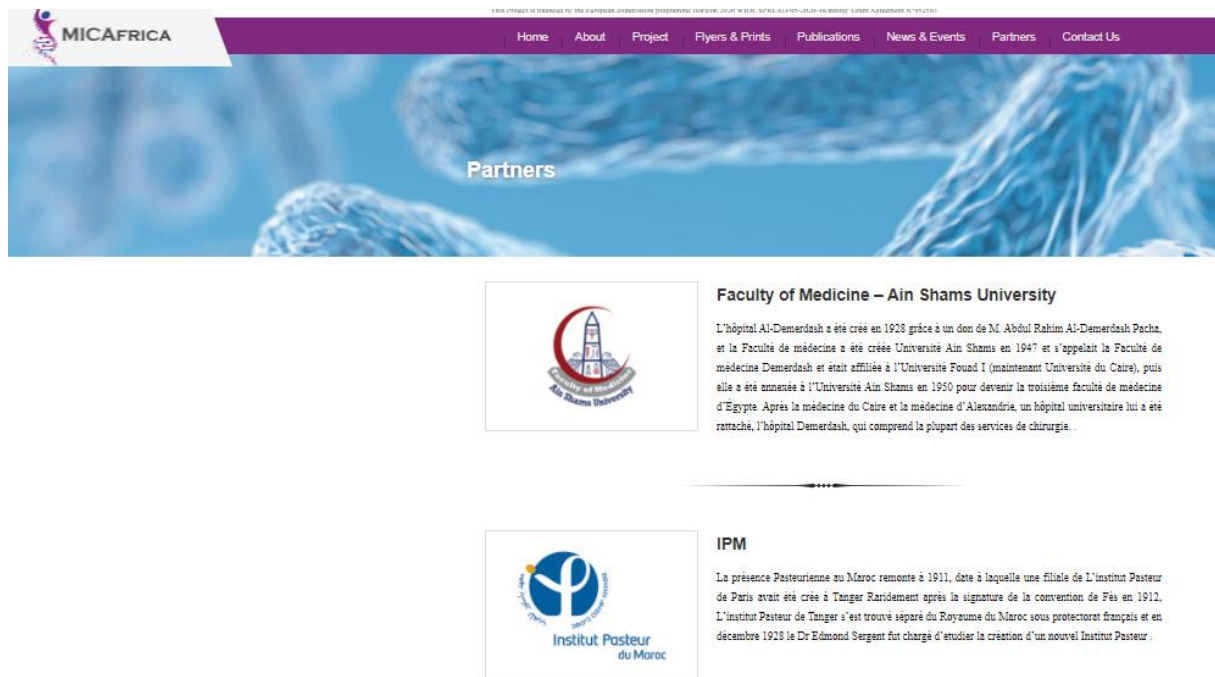


Figure 7: screenshot of partners section

- This section contains information on the MICAfrica's partners details (Figure 7).

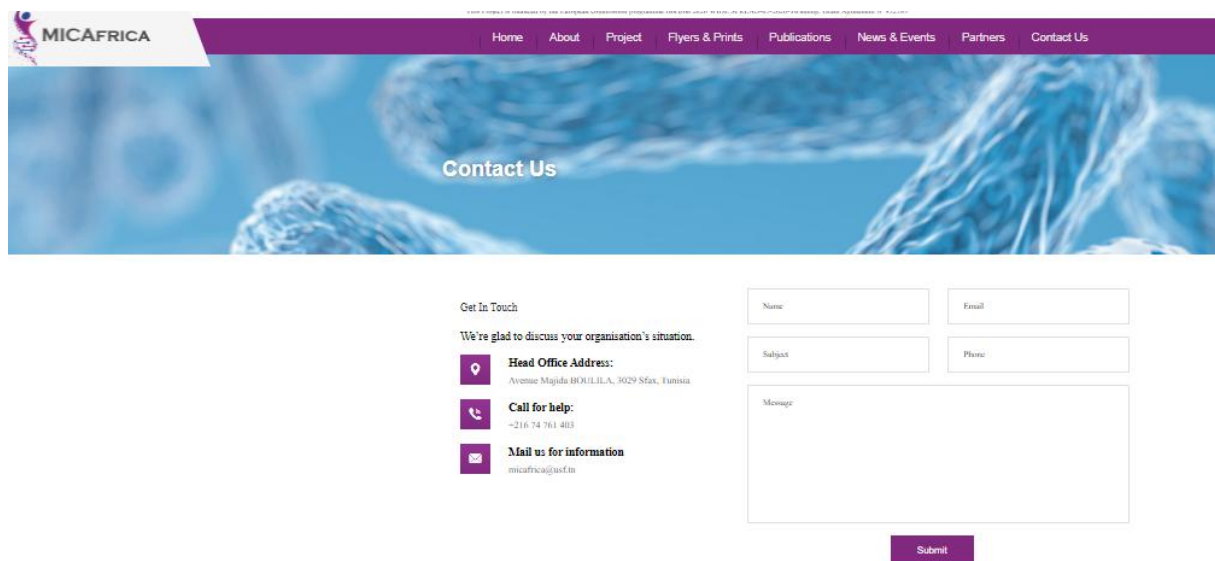


Figure 8: screenshot of contact us section.
